Welcome to Advanced Sorting Extension for Magento 2 developed by Sparsh.

This extension allows customers to sort products by Best Sellers, Top Rated, New Arrivals, Most Viewed, and Reviews Count options on catalog listing page.

## KEY FEATURES:

- ❖ Easy To Install & Manage
- ❖ Enable/Disable from the backend
- ❖ Select multiple sort options
- ❖ Multi-Store Supported
- ❖ Elasticsearch Supported
- ❖ 100% Open Source

## 1. HOW TO ENABLE ADVANACED SORTING

In order to use this extension, you first need to enable it from backend.

Go to Magento 2 Admin > Login > Stores > Configuration > Sparsh Extensions > Advanced Sorting.

Expand the **General Settings** section, and do the following:

- **Enable:** Select “Yes” to enable for selection sorting options on category page.

Select Yes to enable this module

## 2. SELECT CATALOG SORT TYPES TO BE SHOWN/ALLOWED ON FRONTEND

Go to Magento 2 Admin > Login > Stores > Configuration > Sparsh Extensions > Advanced Sorting.

Expand the **General Settings** section, and do the following:

- **Select Catalog Sort Type:** Uncheck “Use system value” checkbox and select types you want to have on frontend.

Available sorting options are:

**Best Sellers** – Products will be sorted by sales quantity

**Top Rated** – Products will be sorted by average ratings

**New Arrivals** – Products will be sorted by the date of creation

**Most Viewed** – Products will be sorted by the number of visits

**Reviews Count** – Products will be sorted by reviews count



### 3. SET UP INDEXER

Go to Magento 2 Admin > Login > System > Tools > Index Management.

Select the checkbox for “Sparsh Advanced Sorting” indexer and set the indexer mode to “Update by Schedule”.

<input type="checkbox"/>	Product Price	Index product prices	UPDATE ON SAVE	READY
<input type="checkbox"/>	Catalog Search	Rebuild Catalog product fulltext search index	UPDATE ON SAVE	READY
<input type="checkbox"/>	Sparsh Advanced Sorting	Advanced Sorting Indexer	UPDATE BY SCHEDULE	READY

#### Note:

1) Make sure that below indexers runs every minute if default Cron indexer is not set on schedule.

*php bin/magento indexer:reindex catalogsearch\_fulltext*

*php bin/magento indexer:reindex sparsh\_advanced\_sorting\_indexer*

2) Sorting result will be affected after indexer is run. So it might be a possible that once users enter review or placing an order, respective sorting will show that result data after a minute.

#### 4. STORE FRONT VIEW

Clear cache from System > Tools > Cache Management if required.

Selected sorting options will be available on Category page as shown below.
