Welcome to Easy Product Tabs Extension for Magento 2 developed by Sparsh.

This extension allows the admin to replace, re-order, customize, rename, and hide the default Magento tabs. It also allows us to create unlimited rule-based informative custom tabs, based on content from cms blocks or widgets or product attributes and attach them to specific products, store views, and customer groups.

KEY FEATURES:

- ❖ Enable/Disable from the backend
- ❖ Create custom tabs with dynamic content
- ❖ Create product tabs based on predetermined rule conditions.
- ❖ Create product tabs that will be visible for targeted audiences like General, Wholesale, or Retailer customer group or to specific websites or store views.
- ❖ Configure sort order for default as well as custom product tabs
- ❖ Option to rename, hide and customize default Magento 2 product tabs
- ❖ Personalize product tab titles with custom text
- ❖ Enhance default Magento 2 product tabs functionality to raise customers' satisfaction and maximize sales
- ❖ Increase a rewarding shopping experience for customers
- ❖ Complement product page by adding images, videos, animations, widgets or variables using WYSIWYG HTML editor
- ❖ Boost the average purchase value by adding Widgets like
 - Show Related Products to Cross & Up-sell
 - Tax details
 - Shipping rules and prices
 - Image and Video gallery
 - FAQ
 - 'Contact us' block
 - Reviews to capture the product in action

- Product conditions
- Return policy
- Any other third-party or default Magento 2 widgets

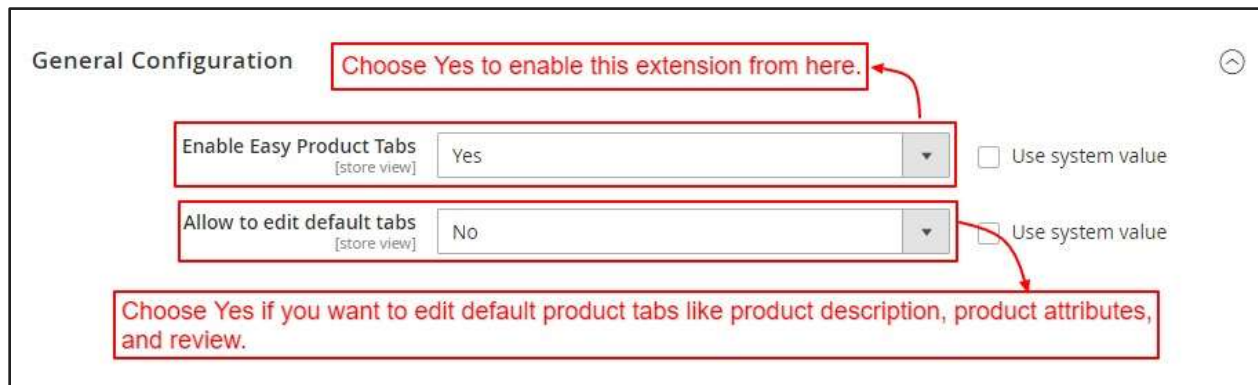
1. HOW TO ENABLE EASY PRODUCT TABS EXTENSION

To use this extension, you first need to enable it from the backend.

Go to Magento 2 Admin > Login > Stores > Configuration > Sparsh Extensions > Easy Product Tabs.

Expand the **General Configuration** section, and do the following:

- **Enable Easy Product Tabs:** Select “Yes” to enable easy product tabs extension.
- **Allow to edit default tabs:** Select “Yes” if you want to edit default product tabs like product description, product attributes, and review.




Once enabled, you will get the “Easy Product Tabs” on the left menu.

2. MANAGE PRODUCT TABS

Go to Magento 2 Admin > Easy Product Tabs (Left menu).

All product tabs will be displayed in the grid view as shown below.

You can edit or delete the product tab from the display grid by choosing the “Edit” or “Delete” option respectively from the action column.

You can also sort/filter them with different attributes like ID, Status, Name, Title, Type, etc.

You can also make multiple product tabs enable/disable/delete simultaneously by using the Action dropdown at the top.

Note 1: You cannot delete default product tabs.


Note 2: You can enable, disable, or edit default product tabs only if it is allowed from the configuration.

3. ADD NEW PRODUCT TAB

Go to Magento 2 Admin > Easy Product Tabs (Left menu) > Add New Product Tab.

You will need to fill out the information defined as below.


- **Enable Tab:** Select the product tab status. By default, this is enabled. If you want to disable the product tab, you can select this field as No.
- **Tab Name:** Enter the product tab name for the backend purposes.
- **Tab Label:** Enter the product tab label which will be shown on the storefront. You can use `{{set_as_default}}` variable for default tab type to display default label.
- **Store Views:** Choose store views for which this product tab will be displayed.

- **Customer Groups:** Choose customer groups for whom this product tab will be displayed.
- **Content:** Enter the product tab content by adding images, videos, animations, widgets, or variables using WYSIWYG HTML editor.

- **Sort Order:** Enter the order of the product tab on the storefront.

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You can use `{!set_as_default!}`-variable for default tab type to display default content.

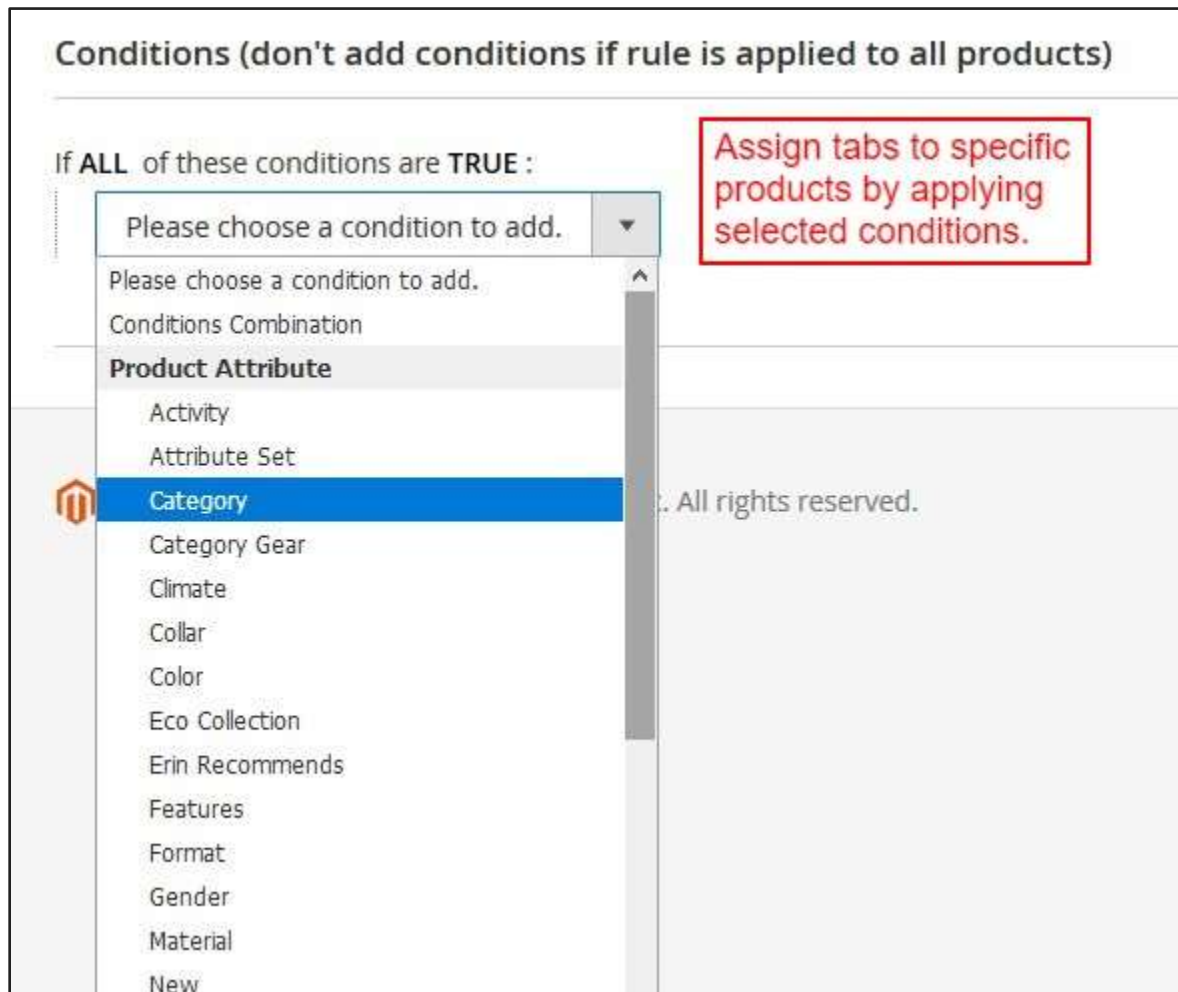
Sort Order * 2

Enter the sort order for product tabs on the storefront.

Make sure that sort order is unique for all tabs.

Expand the **Conditions** section, and do the following:

Add rule-based conditions based on product attributes for which this product tab will be visible. By default, it will be visible on all product pages.



After adding information, click the `Save` button to save the product tab.

You need to clear cache from System > Tools > Cache Management once to have this in effect on the storefront.

4. STOREFRONT VIEW

You will get the product tabs as shown below based on conditions, customer groups, and the store views configuration done in the backend.
