



PRODUCT ATTACHMENT

USER GUIDE

Version 1.1.0

Welcome to Product Attachment Extension for Magento 2 developed by Sparsh.

This extension is used to assign an attachment to more than one products directly which will be visible on front end on product detail page as in additional tab.

Every below steps helps to show product attachment on your site.

1. HOW TO ENABLE/DISABLE EXTENSION GLOBALLY

Go to [Magento 2 Admin] > Stores > Settings > Configuration > Sparsh Extensions > Product Attachment

You can enable / disable this extension globally for all products from here. On disabling it, “Attachments” tab on product detail page in store front won’t be shown.

You can also change the label and set the order of attachments tab from here.



2. HOW TO UPLOAD AN ATTACHMENT TO PRODUCTS

Go to [Magento 2 Admin] > Login > Catalog > Product Attachment > Manage Product Attachment > Add New Attachment

Fill the form details to add a new attachment:

- **Title:** Title of the attachment which will be visible on frontend
- **Status:** Admin can set status as enabled or disabled according to requirements.
- **Sort Order:** Order to display attachments on front. E.g. 1, 2, 3 ... It will be displayed in ascending order.
- **Upload Attachment:** Attachment to display on product detail page. Allowed extensions : jpg , png , jpeg , jfif , gif , bmp , ods , doc , docx , xls , xlsx , pdf , csv , txt , rtf

After that, you need to link this attachment to related products. You can link this to multiple products.

You can filter / search related products as per Magento default widget functionality. You can also find already linked products by choosing "Yes" in first checkbox column.

Note: While editing the record, by default, it shows only those products which are assigned with checkbox column header selected as "Yes". To assign more products, you need to first change the filter from "Yes" to "Any" or "No" and click on the "search" button to find the unassigned products.

Go to [Magento 2 Admin] > Login > Catalog > Product Attachment > Manage Product Attachment

You can find all attachments added here. Attachment grid has details like Title, Status, Created Date and Modified Date of all attachments of the website.






