Welcome to Video Gallery Extension for Magento 2 developed by Sparsh.

This extension is used to display videos on your storefront. You can use it anywhere like the home page or any other pages. It is a perfect marketing tool for your business that provides Video Gallery to your existing customers.

**Every below steps helps to show video gallery on your site.**

## 1. HOW TO ADD NEW VIDEO DETAILS

Go to [Magento 2 Admin] > Login > Video Gallery > Add New Video

Fill the form details to add a new video:

- **Video Title:** Title of the video.
- **Video Upload Method:** Choose video upload method. Choose “From PC” if it is on your local computer / network or Choose “Youtube” if it is on YouTube or Choose “Vimeo” if it is on Vimeo.
- **From PC:** Browse the video from your local computer or network. Allowed video type: mp4
- **Youtube Code:** Add code from YouTube link. E.g. 'XXXXXXXXXXXX' from <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=XXXXXXXXXXXX>
- **Vimeo Code:** Add code from Vimeo link. E.g. 'XXXXXXXXXXXX' from <https://vimeo.com/XXXXXXXXXXXX>
- **Video Description:** Description of the video.
- **Store Views:** Choose store views for which this video will be displayed.
- **Customer Groups:** Choose customer groups for whom this video will be displayed.
- **Position:** Position / Order to display videos on front. E.g. 0, 1, 2 ... It will be displayed in ascending order.
- **Status:** Status can be set as enabled or disabled according to requirements.



### 3. HOW TO SET TITLE FOR VIDEO GALLERY

Go to [Magento 2 Admin] > Stores > Settings > Configuration > Sparsh Extensions > Video Gallery

### 4. HOW TO ADD VIDEO GALLERY WIDGET FOR GIVEN CMS PAGE

Go to [Magento 2 Admin] > Login > Content > Elements > Pages > Add / Edit Page  
Open “Content” > Click on “Show / Hide Editor” button > Click on “Insert Widget” button

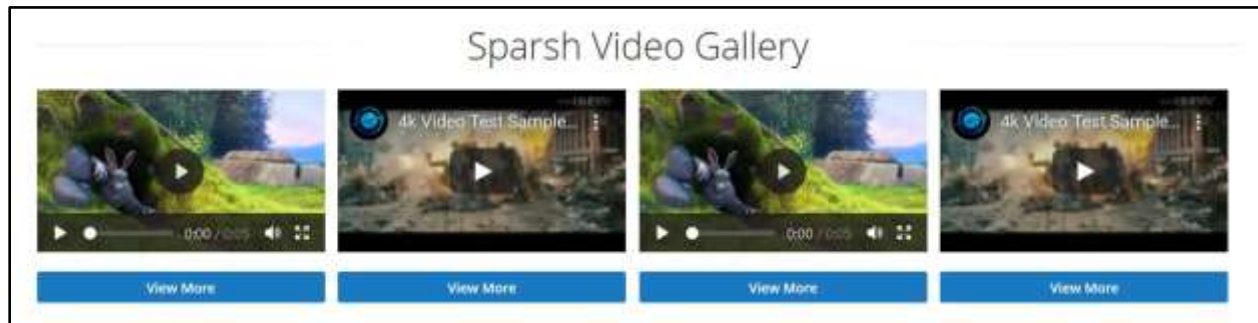
Choose Widget Type as “Video Gallery” > Click on “Insert Widget” button



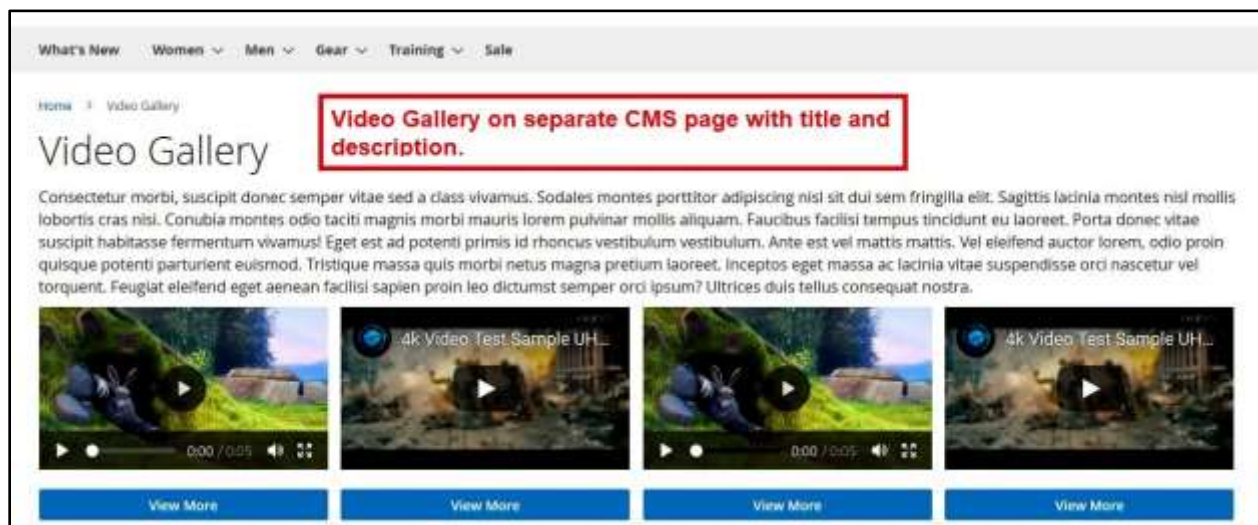
## 5. STORE FRONT VIEW

Showing your video gallery like below on storefront.

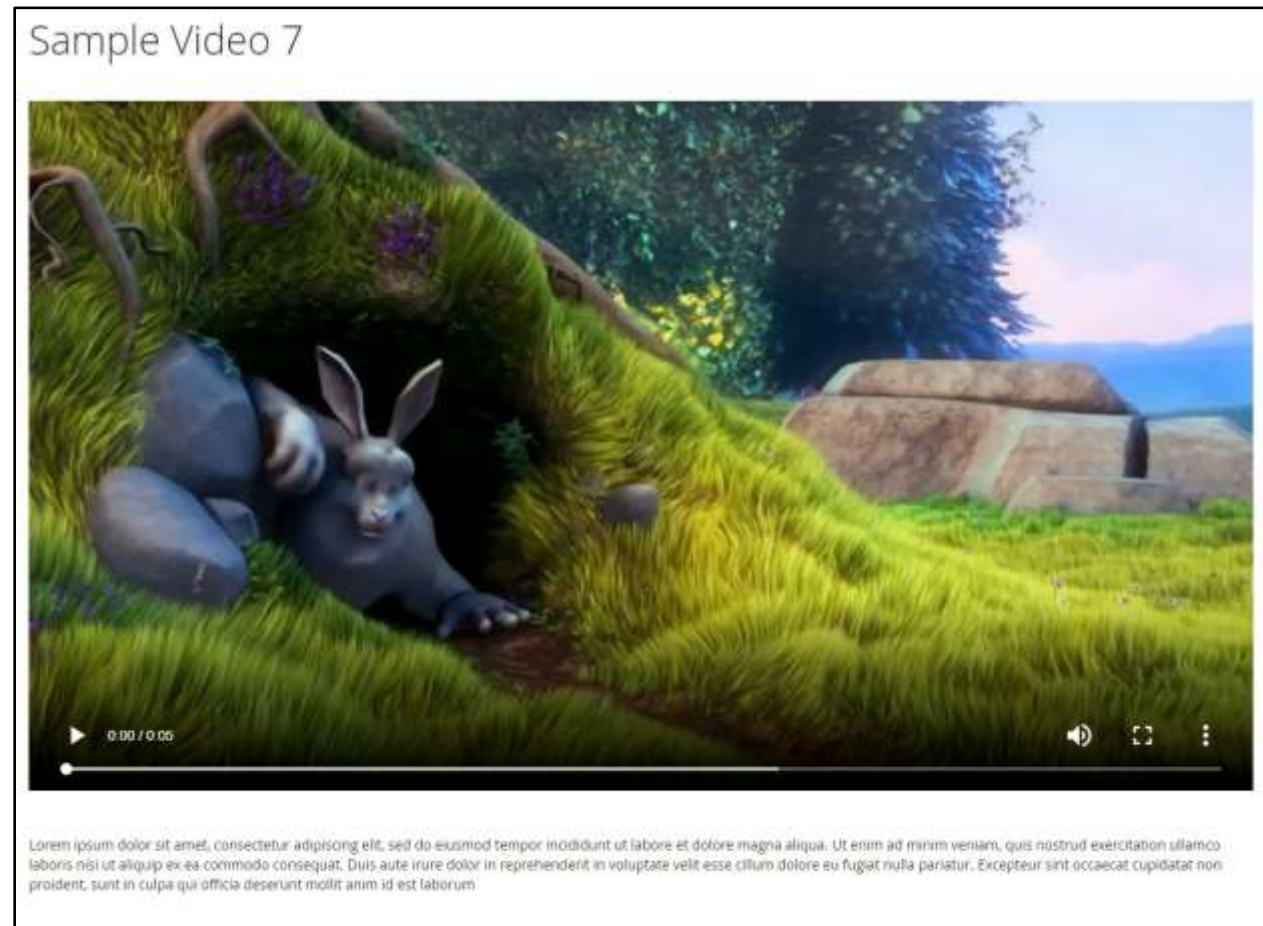


## 6. VIDEO GALLERY ON SEPARATE CMS PAGE WITH TITLE AND DESCRIPTION
